Overview/Location

Owner run and managed, Walkers Plains Camp is located in the Timbavati Private Nature Reserve, forming part of the Greater Kruger National Park. The area is renowned for its excellent game viewing and birdwatching opportunities in truly unspoilt wilderness. The lodge is set on an open plain savannah with expansive views overlooking grasslands and the Drakensberg mountains. Walkers Plains Camp offers an unforgettable wildlife experience.

Weather & Season

- Walkers Plains Camp is open all year round and enjoys a sub-tropical climate with the rainy season in the summer months and enjoyable cool winter evenings.
- Dry season is generally from April to October
- Wet season from November to March

By Air

- Daily flights into Hoedspruit **from Cape Town and Johannesburg** with Airlink and CemairFederal Airline flights into Rockfig airstrip (Includes complimentary transfers from Rockfig airstrip)
- Private charters can be arranged on request
- Transfers from Hoedspruit Eastgate Airport can be arranged at an additional cost

By Road

- Approximately 30 minutes drive from Hoedspruit town
- Approximately 20 minutes drive from Hoedspruit Eastgate Airport
- Approximately 20 minutes drive from Rockfig airstrip
- Approximately 6 hours from Johannesburg International Airport

DIRECTIONS TO WALKERS PLAINS CAMP - 24°20'53.3"S 31°10'48.3"E

From Johannesburg by road

- Head out on the N4 towards Witbank.
- Take the off ramp for Belfast (R33 / R540).
- Upon reaching Belfast town, make a right onto Voortrekker Street and stay on R540 towards Dullstroom.
- Drive straight through Dullstroom and keep going towards Lydenburg.
- Upon reaching Lydenburg, take a left onto Potgieter Street & continue straight on R36 towards Ohrigstad.
- Drive through Ohrigstad on R36, ignoring the left turn towards Tzaneen.
- Instead, stay straight on R531 towards Hoedspruit.
- In Hoedspruit, cross the bridge over the train line at the four-way stop, turning right towards Bosbokrand / Bushbuckridge on the R40.
- About 6/7km from Hoedspruit, see the Eastgate Airport sign on the left.
- Take this left turn onto the Argyle Rd
- Continue for approximately 15km on the Argyle Rd until you reach the Timbavati Private Nature Reserve Control Gate (Enkhulu Gate).
- Once through the gate continue for 2.5 km on Argyle Rd until you see the sign for Walkers Plains Camp.
- Turn Right at the Walkers Plains Camp Sign and follow the road for 500m until you reach Walkers Plains Camp

From Sabi Sands by road

- After departing from Shaw's Gate or Newington Gate at the Sabi Sand Reserve, take a right onto the R536 heading towards Hazyview.
- Upon reaching the first traffic light when entering Hazyview, make a right onto the R40, passing Perry's Bridge Trading Post and Hippo Hollow Country Estate on your left, continuing towards Bushbuckridge.
- Proceed through Bushbuckridge and Accornhoek while staying on the R40 towards Hoedspruit.
- When you see the sign for "Hoedspruit," make a right and continue for approximately 17km.
- About 8km before reaching Hoedspruit, turn right at the sign indicating "Timbavati & Eastgate Airport."
- Drive for approximately 15km until you arrive at the Timbavati Private Nature Reserve Control Gate (Enkhulu Gate).
- Once through the gate continue for 2.5 km on Argyle Rd until you see the sign for Walkers Plains Camp.
- Turn Right at the Walkers Plains Camp Sign and follow the road for 500m until you reach Walkers Plains Camp

From Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport

- Upon exiting the airport at the turning circle, make a right turn.
- At the first stop street, turn left onto Plaston Road, and continue straight ahead.
- At the T-junction, make a right turn towards White River. Once in White River, make a left turn at the second traffic light (near Ntt Toyota), then a right turn at the first traffic light.
- Turn left onto the R40 and continue straight towards Hazyview.
- Drive through Hazyview on the R40 and proceed towards Bushbuckridge and Accornhoek. Follow the directions from Hazyview (from Sabi Sands by road).

Please do not use your GPS after Hoedspruit as the directions are incorrect and could mean an unnecessary detour to reach us.
